19 centers of research and formation

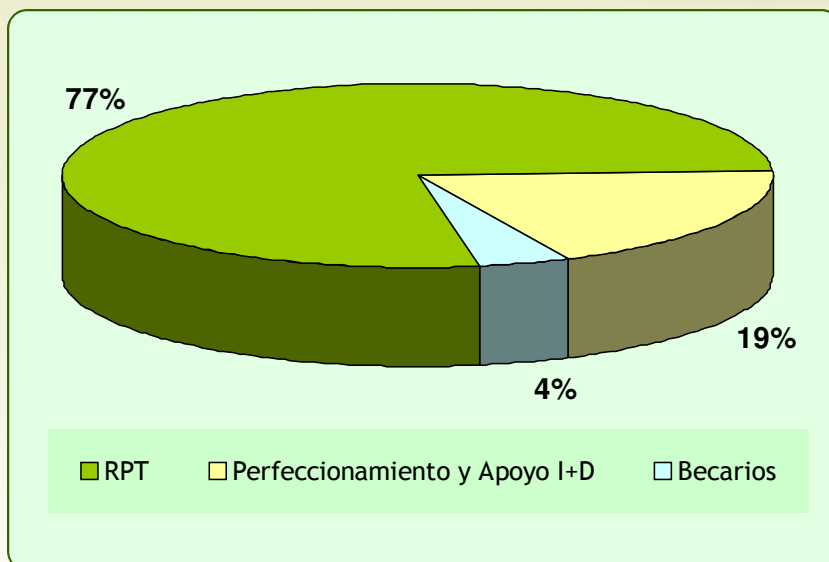
